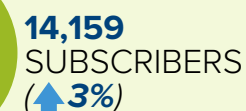

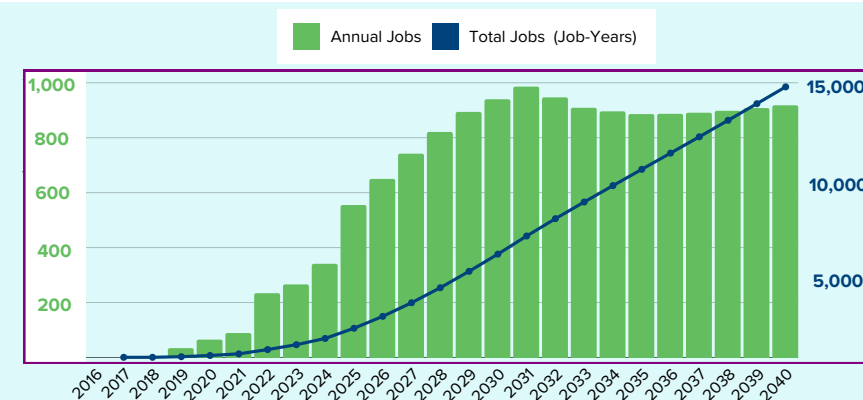
RIVER RESILIENCE BRIEFINGS

RURAL ENERGY SAVINGS PROGRAM CREATES JOBS!



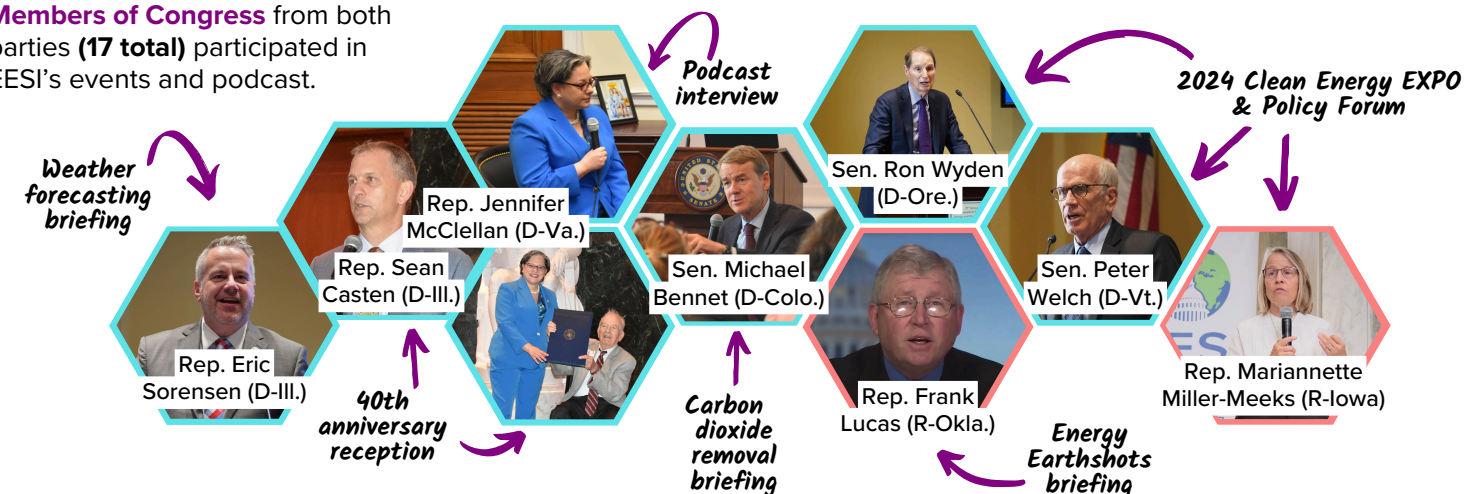
A 2024 analysis showed that USDA's Rural Energy Savings Program **already supports jobs in rural areas** with the potential to help create **hundreds more each year** (green bars).

The blue line represents **total jobs supported between 2016 and 2040** (projected).

EESI has helped rural utilities secure **RESP** loans worth **\$320 million** since 2016.
