Environment & Energy Congressional Round-Up | November 24 - November 28, 2025

The House Committee on Energy and Commerce advanced the *Reliable Power Act* (H.R.3616). Reps. Troy Balderson (R-Ohio), Randy Weber (R-Texas) and Julie Fedorchak (R-N.D.) introduced the bill to <u>protect</u> the U.S. electric grid. Specifically, the bill, if passed, would order federal agencies to consider how new regulations impact grid reliability. The House Committee on Natural Resources advanced the *Water Rights Protection Act* (<u>H.R.302</u>). The bill, reintroduced by Reps. Celeste Maloy (R-Utah) and six Republican cosponsors, would <u>prohibit</u> the federal government from seizing privately owned waters and reaffirm state water law.
