Environment & Energy Congressional Round-Up | September 15 - September 19, 2025

The House passed the *Water Resources Technical Assistance Review Act* (<u>H.R.3427</u>), which aims to <u>ensure</u> the availability of the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA's) water infrastructure resources for small, rural, and economically disadvantaged communities. The bill, introduced by Rep. David Taylor (R-Ohio) and cosponsored by Reps. Shomari Figures (D-Ala.) and Laura Gillen (D-N.Y.), mandates a report on the EPA's work on clean water technical assistance. The bill now moves to the Senate for consideration.

The House Committee on Natural Resources passed the *Post-Disaster Reforestation* and *Restoration Act of 2025* (<u>H.R.528</u>). Reps. Brittany Pettersen (D-Colo.) and Chuck Edwards (R-N.C.) reintroduced the bill, which would <u>bolster</u> recovery and resilience efforts in communities struck by natural disasters.

The House Committee on Natural Resources also passed the *Make SWAPs Efficient Act of 2025* (H.R.1676). The bill, introduced by Reps. Byron Donalds (R-Fla.) and Jared Moskowitz (D-Fla.), aims to improve government efficiency in conservation. State Wildlife Action Plans (SWAPs) identify non-game species in greatest need of conservation. The bill, if passed, directs the Secretary of the Interior to approve SWAPs within 180 days. Currently, they do not have a set deadline and usually take over 18 months for approval.

The House Committee on Natural Resources passed the *Great Lakes Fishery Research Reauthorization Act* (H.R.1809). Reps. Mike Quigley (D-III.) and Bill Huizenga (R-Mich.) reintroduced the bill, to provide continued <u>funding</u> to the U.S. Geological Survey for research on and protection of the Great Lakes' native fish populations and habitats. Sens. Gary Peters (D-Mich.) and Jon Husted (R-Ohio) introduced the bill's companion (<u>S.2878</u>) in the Senate.
