




- November 10-21, 2025



Where are we today on NDC ambition?

- Only one-third of Parties (63) have announced new NDCs
- That represents only half of global GHG emissions under new 2035 NDCs
- @NY Climate Week, China pledged to cut GHG emissions to 7-10% below peak levels by 2035
- Russia, Turkey, and several other large emitters have submitted
- EU, India, Indonesia and Mexico not yet submitted

One-third of nations – covering half of global emissions – have submitted or announced 2035 climate pledges
